History

Nanteos Mansion sits directly on the site of a much earlier manor house, Neuadd Llawdden. This house can still be found in the cellars of Nanteos, with the front door and windows still in tact. The flooring beneath that house dates back to the 11th century and previous inhabitants.

The building of Nanteos began in 1739 under the direction of Thomas Powell, MP for Cardiganshire, funded by the considerable wealth of his wife Mary Frederick, granddaughter of Sir John Frederick, Lord Mayor of London. Thomas however, died before the work was completed and the estate was left to his brother, the Reverend William Powell to complete the work in 1752. Nanteos remained a family home for the next 180 years, until the last surviving Powell - Edward Powell died in 1930. Margaret Powell, his wife, remained in residence until her death in 1951. In its heyday the Nanteos estate totalled some 33,000 acres throughout Cardiganshire (today's Ceredigion.)

For the next 60 years a succession of owners and lack of sufficient investment or vision saw a decline in the fortunes of the estate and the mansion fell into disrepair. But following a multi-million pound equity investment the Grade 1 listed mansion, together with its Grade 2* stables, Grade 2* walled garden and 30 acres of grounds, have been sympathetically restored and in Spring 2012 opened as Nanteos Mansion country house hotel.

Elegance

If the tranquillity of its location doesn't immediately touch your soul, then the opulent décor, sumptuous rooms, fine dining and discreet, attentive service will surely combine to cast aside the realities of everyday life. At Nanteos it's all about you. Somewhere to come and go as you please; where privacy is assured and where time, if you want it to, stands still.

Accommodation comprises thirteen rooms and a four-bedroom mews house. The latter is available as self-catering or serviced accommodation.

All the rooms have been sympathetically restored to preserve many original features, including the paper mache ornate ceiling with portraits of Milton and Shakespeare in the details and the famous music room, licensed for civil ceremonies.

The whole hotel is furnished and decorated to the highest standards, reflecting the period of the Mansion but with some contemporary twists and all modern conveniences. Rooms are named after people, places and events associated with the Mansion's prominent and illustrious past and the culture and vision of its new owners whose energy and commitment is helping to secure Nanteos's future for generations to come.
